Compton Community College District Schedules Information Sessions for Individuals Interested in Serving on Board of Trustees

The Compton Community College District (CCCD) has scheduled two information sessions for individuals who are interested in serving on the District's Board of Trustees. Both sessions will take place via the Zoom. The candidate information sessions are scheduled for:

- July 22, 2020, at 6:00 p.m.
- August 19, 2020, at 6:00 p.m.

The information sessions are for candidates vying for two open seats in the November 3, 2020 election for CCCD Trustee Areas 2 and 3.

Trustee Area 2 includes Willowbrook, Enterprise, Compton, and West Rancho Dominguez; and Trustee Area 3 includes Lynwood, South Gate, Paramount, and Downey. Trustees elected in November 2020 for Trustee Areas 2 and 3 will serve a term of four years, commencing on the second Friday in December subsequent to their election.

The information sessions will provide an opportunity for candidates to receive an update on the CCCD and Compton College including academic and job training programs offered at Compton College, enrollment for summer and fall at Compton College, a campus facilities update, an update on the District's response to COVID-19, an Accreditation update, and more.
